Informant advised that he is unable to evaluate what prompted LOMAN to react as he did, whether he has simply decided to renounce his revolutionary past or if he has been contacted by FRANK and told to completely disassociate himself from any further contact with the AHC.

Chicago recalls that when contacted by CG 6547-S and LEIBEL BERGMAN, in April, 1968, LOMAN was semi-hostile, indicated no sympathy for a revolutionary solution to the Afro-American problems, and expressed himself as in agreement with the solution offered by the late Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY and the non-violent program of the late Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING.

On the other hand, however, it is quite possible that SUE FRANK did contact LOMAN after informant used LOMAN's name in making contact with her in July. This would be in keeping with her reputation for shrewdness and caution in all political activities.

LOMAN's use of the word "phonies" would portend that possibly he has been informed that there is reason to doubt the authenticity of the AHC. Another possibility is that LOMAN, from reading the Ad Hoc Bulletin has come to the conclusion that the ideology of the AHC is too unrealistic for the present political scene.

for AHC informants to again contact FRANK. It is imperative that any question raised as to the legitimacy of the AHC be resolved at least to the extent of pinpointing the source of such allegation. To avoid FRANK would possibly substantiate such allegation, if one exists.

Informants will travel to New York via American Airlines, flight 312, leaving Chicago at 11:00 a.m., 10/28/68. They will stay at the Lexington Hotel if accommodations are available and return to Chicago at the conclusion of their business on either 10/29 or 30/68.

Informants have been briefed in accordance with referenced Bureau letter as to their contacts with FRANK and the Albanian mission to the United Nations. In addition they will contact NY1656-S.

Should the necessity arise to contact the New York Office, they have been furnished the name of SA JOHN J. ELLIOTT.
