The Miami Division is requested to advise San Juan of the travel of any top functionaries so that they can be observed in Puerto Rico.

For the information of Miami, JERONIMO ESTEVE is identical to SJ 492-S, one of the most prolific sources in the Cuban field in the San Juan Office. He was asked if he had made or plans to make a contribution to ALPHA 66. He answered that he has no plans in this regard and that they cannot succeed because FIDEL CASTRO is too strong and any revolution would lack the support of the U.S. government.
