Interview with ARTHUR was conducted on 10/23/63, by SAs ROBERT F. MAHLER and H. THOMAS FORSHA, during which time ARTHUR was informed it was felt he was not telling completely truthful facts and that he was withholding information. He admitted he believed he had information from sources which he would not divulge because he trusted no one. He refused to elaborate on this statement.

In his telephone conversation with one of the interviewing Agents subsequent to the interview, ARTHUR, in addition to expressing his fears for having furnished the information, stated he is considering furnishing further information "at some other time."

CI T-1 is former CI 106-S who could furnish no information regarding ARTHUR.
