Reference is made to my letter dated April 3, 1964, which advised that inquiries were being conducted to determine if three former sources of this Eureau could be made available to testify at an administrative hearing in the Passport Office regarding the possible Communist Party membership of Susan Heiligman Frank.

The source identified as T-6 in the report of Special Agent Daniel A. Flynn dated July 2, 1963, at New York, New York, is not available to testify at an administrative hearing.

Special Agent Gerald P. Reidy dated November 25, 1959, at New York, New York, is a former source of the Bureau. This individual is Ethel Klein Newton, who has previously testified as a Government witness before the Subversive Activities Control Board. Mrs. Newton advised on April 3, 1964, that she is available and willing to testify at an administrative hearing in the Passport Office.

State Department by letter 3/25/64 requested advice as to whether ten specific sources previously utilized in Bureau reports could be made available to testify at an administrative hearing regarding the subject's Communist Party membership. The sources listed by State Department relate to seven sources of this Bureau. Our letter of 4/3 advised State Department that four of the sources were not available to testify and the remaining three informants of interest were former sources and inquiries were being made regarding their availability. Former NY 3234-S has advised she is not willing to testify for personal reasons. This former source is the wife of Aaron Cohen who recently testified before the Subversive Activities Control Board in New York City. Former NY 1086-S is Ethel Klein Newton, who is willing and available to testify at an administrative hearing and, therefore, State Department is being advised of her identity.
