On January 27, 1959, MM 639-S advised that PEDRO LUIS DIAZ LANZ had returned to Cuba and had been appointed as head of the Cuban Air Force.

On January 29, 1959, MM 635-S advised that ANTONIO SANSON CASANOVA had returned to Cuba, was residing there, and was employed as an air line pilot.

On February 4, 1959, Mr. DAVID C. CLARK, Assistant United States Attorney, Miami, advised he declined prosecution, inasmuch as both subjects are no longer living in the United States.
