ReNYtel 9/27/65, captioned "Cuban Mission to
 the UN, IS - CUBA." (u)

MM761-S advised on 9/27/65, that on instant date he attempted to see a friend, CARLOS TEPEDINO, a jeweler, 31 West 47th Street, NYC, who, according to the source, is in contact with CIA, but learned that TEPEDINO had departed for Italy on Sunday evening, 9/26/65. TEPEDINO's father told source that MARTA JIMENEZ (a member of the ROA Delegation to the UN) had called and said she had a letter and some cigars for CARLOS from ROLANDO (CUBELA). Source explained that CUBELA was a former "commandante" and a former student leader at the University of Havana who in the past while in Europe had been in contact with CIA. (u)

On 9/28/65, MM 761-S advised that OSCAR GUTIERREZ (3rd Secretary) from the Cuban Mission to the UN and another unidentified male delivered the aforementioned cigars and letter to TEPEDINO, SR. on the afternoon of 9/27/65, at which time source was present. He met GUTIERREZ and in casual conversation he "learned" that the Foreign Minister (ROA) was in New York and would address the UN General Assembly. (u)
