Synopsis of Facts: TERESA PROENZA, a 36-year-old Cuban national, is a member of the Communist Party of Cuba and active in numerous front organizations and in social and cultural circles known to be party dominated. On returning recently from an alleged business trip to Mexico, she related to a reliable Source some of her activities while in Mexico and indicated she had interviewed the Russian Ambassador there and had learned through friends that the Russian Embassy is making great progress in Mexico. She is now reportedly the Cuban representative of OVERSEAS NEWS AGENCY, which she terms a progressive American news syndicate. Other reliable Sources reveal Subject has been assisting the Russian Press Attaché by arranging meetings for her with Cubans whom she desires to meet. Subject attends all Russian Legation affairs, usually receiving a special invitation from the Press Attaché. Subject's Communist contacts and additional background information set forth.
