Re San Jaan radiogram deted 10/26/65 concerning information from Coast Guard at San Juan relative to plane of a Cuban exile group to sabotage in some U.S. port, a vessel trading with Cuba, and San Juan radiogram dated 10/21/66, concerning information from Coast Gaard, San Juan, that the Coast Guard at Miami may have receive information concerning captioned mining prior to the actual occurrence.

On the night of October 26, 1965, Commander JOSEPH WARD, Intelligence Officer, U. S. Coast Guard, Hiami, advised that on Saturday, October 23, 1965, he received a hand delivered report at his home from a third agoncy which, although not mentioned by him. can only be CEA, Miami, This report describes the plan of an anti-CASTRO organization to bosh a ship at some port in U. S. territory. (5)

Commandor (Cadr.) WARD said he was restricted by the "third party rule" and that the written report (S)

delivered to his was accompanied by a cover letter which contained the usual phraseology concerning the sensitivity of the source and that any investigation might compromise the sources. In addition, Cadr. WARD said he was advised in subsequent telephonic contact by the third party agency that the source was vulnerable to the point that any ingiry in this matter would expose him. Cadr. WARD stated that the source was reported to be a member of a recently formed secret cell of the organization involved in the plot and the source apparently was a direct participant in the plot. (5)

Cadr. WHED said that the "third party" agency report gave only the name of the organization and its leader, and the reasoning behind the bombing plans which were, (1) to increase insurance rates of ships in commerce with Cube, (2) to intimidate seamen from working on such ships, and (3) to break up the co-existence policy of the U. S. and Cubs. (5)

Cadr. WARD said that the British, Spanish and Japanese ships were indicated as the objectives of the anit-CASTRO organization. (5)

Cheir. WARD stated there was no indication of the extent of dissemination of the "third party" agency report, but he was required by that agency to submit for approval, a persphrased version of the information which he did send to Coast Guard Hendquarters in Washington, D.C. and to the ports within the 7th Coast Guard District, which are principally Jacksonville, San Juan and Thapa. The Coast Guard Hendquarters then sent the rephrased message to the Director of the various Coast Guard Districts throughout the U.S., Alaska and Havaii. The Captains of Port of the Coast Guard, according to Cadr. WARD, are initiating increased vigilance with respect to (\$7

CMDR. WARD also asked if the plot excluded the group planning the Satrustegui bombing and he mplied in the negative. He was asked if the plot included any group other than that claiming the Satrustegui bombing, and the response was also in the negative. (3)

From the foregoing, contact with Ondr. WARD, it would appear evident that he is referring to informa-tion classified "Secret" which was received by FBI, Hiami from CIA, Miami on October 20, 1965. With reference to San Juan radiogram deted October 21, 1965, Cadr, WARD advised that he had not received any "third party" report prior to captioned mining to the effect that the MER was planning the mining of Satrustegui. He said that his office has received a series of "third party" reports concerning plans of ORLANDO BOSCH and the MINE all of which were indefinite and incking in detail other than the statement of the overall plan of declaration of war by BOSCH against shipping of countries dealing with Caba. (S)
