Mr. SHANLEY explained that he has an informant
in DIAZ LANZ's group at the present time, and expects to
know of any trips DIAZ LANZ may take in the future. SHANLEY
said that U. S. Customs keeps a log on DIAZ LANZ's two boats,
and this log reflects DIAZ left Miami on the 22nd of January,
and returned on January 28, 1963, at which time U. S. Customs
boarded and inspected the boat. However, Customs did not
find any automatic weapons or contraband. (X)(u)
