Re Mex lets 3-27-69 and 5-19-69. J

The lead originally assigned to CS MEX-134 was re-directed to a PSI in the Federal Judicial Police on transfer to Yucatan, as it was hoped his Federal employment might give him ready access to the information desired. The PSI, however, was unable to cover the lead which has now been given to CS MEX-134. (u)

In view of the difficulty which is being experienced by the informants, and which was encountered by the American Consulate in Merida in obtaining the desired Federal Attorney General's representative's reports in this matter, and in view of the past reluctance of the Mexican Government to authorize any Mexican officials to testify in a U.S. court even when the offense occurred in Mexico, as will be observed in the case also involving FRANK FIORINI entitled "FRANK ANGELO FIORINI; ET AL; REPORTED PLANS TO BLOW UP CUBAN SHIP IN MEXICAN PORT, POSSIBLY VERACRUZ, IS - CUBA," (BuFile 105-165503, Miami File 105-12890), the Miami Office is requested to advise whether additional efforts to obtain the Federal reports at Merida is desirable or necessary. (u)

In the meantime, Mexico City will continue to follow the efforts of CS MEX-134 to obtain the information. (u)
