ALL INFORMATION CONTAINED
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Reference is made to my letter dated May 4, 1961,
in the captioned matter.

On May 17, 1961, an informant, who has furnished
reliable information in the past, advised the Miami, Florida,
office of this Bureau that Gerald Patrick Manning, described
as the leader of the captioned organization, has been in
contact with Augustin Cape, a Cuban national in Miami. Cape
allegedly has access to a PT boat and a quantity of radio
equipment. Cape planned to make a reconnaissance trip to
Cay Aguililla and Cay Sol Bank, British islands north of Cuba,
on May 17, 1961. Cape will return to Miami and on May 20, 1961,
will return to Cay Aguililla by the same PT boat. Cape will
take with him Manning and 15 to 20 Americans who are members
of the captioned organization. The informant expects that
Manning and the group will have arms and will attempt to
operate out of Cay Aguililla against Cuba on commando raids.

This informant subsequently advised on May 17, 1961,
that the PT boat reconnaissance trip had been canceled and
will probably be made on May 22, 1961. The subsequent
expedition is being organized for the weekend of May 27,
1961. Informant indicated that this expedition will also include
Orlando Garcia, associate of Maurice Sanchez Arango who is
head of an anti-Castro organization known as
Triple A, and Gerald Patrick Manning and his two
associates, Robert Miller and William and Dick Gentry.
