Mr. WALLACE SHANLEY, U. S. Customs, Miami, Fla., confidentially advised that *EDWARD GERMAIN*, Marathon, Fla. *X* was cooperating with Customs. *(X/m)*

SHANLEY said Customs immediately instituted a physical surveillance of HEMMING's boat, the "Sally", and Custom's Agents will stop and board this boat if HEMMING tries to go on a military expedition. *(X/m)*
