Enclosed LHM is being classified CONFIDENTIAL, CONTROLLED DISSEM, inasmuch as it contains information from CIA so classified. ~~CONFIDENTIAL~~ (X)(U)

On 8-3-66, MM 639-S and MM 635-S, and on July 29, 1966, MM 492-S were contacted with negative results concerning captioned organization. (X)(U)

It is noted on the last page of referenced CIA report under "Source Comment", it is stated that NEGRIN and GARCIA appear to be the only leaders and the only known members of captioned organization. (X)(U)

Accordingly, inasmuch as established sources and informants advised this group is unknown, has no activity, and is probably just a paper organization, no further inquiry is being conducted by the Miami Office.
