Customs Agency, Miami, is presently endeavoring to locate and interview HIRSH GONZALEZ concerning the 30th of November Organization's participation in the alleged flight on May 25, 1964 over Cuba. Customs is also attempting to locate and interview JAMES BUCKNER, who, according to FRANK ANTHONY STURGIS, admittedly made the alleged flight on May 25, 1964.

When ARTHUR ENO, head of FAA, Miami, contacted SA FRANK P. CRIVELLO of this office on May 27, 1964, ENO said he had information that General JUDY, North American Defense Command, 32nd Air Division, Montgomery, Alabama, was flying into Miami to conduct an inquiry and that JUDY indicated he desired to confer with the FBI concerning this matter.

On the morning of May 28, 1964, Colonel NOLEN C. JOHNSON, Jr., Director of Plans, 32nd NORAD Region, Air Force Base, Montgomery, Alabama, contacted the Director
