According to NY 2816-S, NY 2705-S, NY 2917-S, NY 3144-S, and NY 2930-S, MARK LANE spoke at a demonstration held by the conference of Greater New York Peace Groups on 5/28/62, in the vicinity of the UN, NYC. Subject spoke on the dangers of a nuclear war.

The above has been placed in the Administrative Section inasmuch as the Bureau approved characterization of the CGNYPG has not been received.

On 4/17/62, NY 694-S* made available the original of a memorandum written by CP functionary ARNOLD JOHNSON for transmittal to the Soviets. This memorandum is entitled "Memo on Peace - Some Brief and Limited Notes", in which JOHNSON describes what he considers the major recent events in the peace movement. Item 7 in this memorandum reads:

"In Politics - The Americans for Democratic Action are pushing the peace platform much more than before. This is highlighted in certain election campaigns such as that of MARK LANE and reformed democrats in New York and in Democratic Party Councils in California. There are also some developments of peace candidates in elections."
