During contact with Mr. WILLIAM BOWDLER, State Dept.,
on 9/23/64, he advised he was returning to Washington, D.C.
on 9/24/64, and that any other matters relating to this in-
cident would be handled by Mr. G. HARVEY SUMM, Office of
Coordinator of Cuban Affairs, Miami. He expressed his complete
satisfaction and stated the investigation conducted by Miami
was "right down the line" in answering the requirements of
the State Dept. with regard to this problem. (M)

Several additional interviews are contemplated on
9/24/64 and, barring unforeseen developments, it is believed
this will complete all remaining logical investigation.
