Re New Orleans sirtel to Hisal, 5/13/66 in captioned matter concerning the speaking tour of CARLOS JOSE BRINGUISA ESPOSITO.

Coverage has been effected on the various specially engagements of BRINGUILR in the Dallas Division and a summary of his activities and of the information received from sources in this division follows:

C3-DL-108% furnished information to 3A MVIN D.
EVIKENDALL on 5/26/64 reflecting approximately 40 persons attended a meeting at the Central Saptist Church, Plane, Tenns, beginning 7:30 PM, 5/23/64. The paster of the church presided and introduced Dr. BILLY JAMES HARGIS. Several patriotic songs were sung and literature of the Christian Anti-Communist Crusade was distributed at the entrance way.

NARGIS introduced CARLOS ERINGUIES as the person who debated LES MARVEY OSVALD in 1963 on a radio program in Louisians. MARGIS said BRIMGUIER had found out OSVALD was a Communist Agent working with CASTRO.

ERINGULER then opens and identified himself as a Cuban. He said his uncle had been an official in Cuba prior to the presidency of Batlata. He also told that FIDEL CASTRO had personally assassinated one of his relatives. BRINGULER described his leaving Cuba and coming to New Orleans, Louisians where he is now a resident. He said he set CSWALD in the middle of 1983 when the latter entered his place of business and advised he was interested in helping BRINGULER train Exile Cubans to fight against CASTRO. BRINGULER said he was suspicious of GSEALD, because a few days prior thereto, he had received information that someone in New Gricans was a pro-Castro spy. BRINGULER said he felt sure as in the creation claimed to Orraid his interesters in the creatization—Caban Student Directo-ete.

DRIMVIER, in this talk, said be had again met OSWALD a few days later on the atrect, carrying a sign announcing his favor of CASTRO. BRINGUIER said he called OSWALD a traitor and a Communist and that they had an argument on the street.

BAINGUINE claimed CSUALD had sent a Marine Training book to him by another person and inside the cover of this book was the name "MIDELL" (phonetic). HEINGUINE claimed he has toraced this book ever to investigative authorities and has told him full story to authorities about him association with GSUALD. He stated CSUALD and he had debated on the radio in New Orleans -- CSUALD being pro-Castro, and BHINGUINE being anti-Castro.

EXINCUIER went on to say be bed belood train
Exile Cubans in New Orleans area and claimed that "we" and
"our people" had recently burned sugar came fields or mills
in Cuba. Se said Cuban Exiles are prepared and willing
to revolt against CASTRO.

BRINGULE had records on sale for \$4.00 each, which allegedly contained a conversation between himself and OSVALD. He was also solling leaflets for \$.25 per copy.

MARGIS therenfter spoke of several political matters. We said BRINGUIES were working for him on a salary basis and BRINGUIES and his group was trying to awaken the public to the Communist menace.

This source further advised it appeared MARCE and ball Willing had one or two other persons traveling with them in a Dodge Mobile Nose. One was a young American-looking man about 18 or 19 years of age who served as an usber at the meeting. Another was a Spanish or Cuban-looking young man about 30, who lead the singing of patriotic songs at the meeting.

Announcements were made of other appearances of MARGIS's group.

CS-DL-103R advised SA EUYKENDALL on 5/25/64, the HARGIS group, including BRINGUIEN had appeared at the Community Hall, also known as city hall, 4100 Clarendon, Cockrell Hill, Texas, at 7:30 PM, 5/25/64. Again HARGIS opened the mosting and introduced BRINGUIEN 201 the Cuban Student Directorate, bendquartered in Hismi, Florida.
