Re New York letter to Director dated 1/31/63.

Doctor ERNESTO ARAGON Y GODOY, 233 East 69th Street, NYC, a delegate of the Consejo Revolucionario de Guba (CRC) contacted the New York Office on March 4, 1963. Doctor ARAGON has been in Nashington, D. C. from January 22, 1963, except for several weekends when he returned to New York. During his stay in Washington, D. C., ARAGON advised that he was handling affairs of the CRC, and was in daily contact with the Pentagon and US Department of State officials.

TRIPS OF DOCTOR JOSE MIRO CARDONA

Doctor ARAGON stated on 3/4/63, that Doctor JOSE MIRO CARDONA, President of the CRC, would depart Minui, Florida with LUIS BYTIFOLL on 3/6/63 for a visit to Guatemala, where he would confer with President MIGUEL YDIGORAS FUENTES. ARAGON stated that KIRO CARDONA had difficulty with YDIGORAS because President YDIGORAS had invited MIRO CARDONA twice to Guatemala to confer with him, and each time MIRO CARDONA declined the invitations. ARAGON stated that he had for some time been trying to settle this misunderstanding between MIRO CARDONA and President YDIGORAS of Guatemala, and finally through the Guatemalan Ambassador to the US, ROBERTO ALEJO, arrangements were made for MIRO CARDONA to meet with him, and discuss problems on 3/7/63. ARACON stated that MIRO CARDONA and BOTIFOLL would probably be in Guatemala from 3/6/63 through 3/8/63, and then return to Miami, Searched_
