The title is marked changed to reflect the identity of REYNOLDS A. MOODY, concerning whom details in the LHM pertain. The title was formerly carried as "COLONEL MOODY."

BRAUER is contained in the aforementioned Tampa report of SA JOHN H. MILLER, May 22, 1964.

The LHM is classified Confidential because it sets forth information received from TP 139-S, the disclosure of whose identity could be detrimental to the national defense.

Local dissemination by the Miami Office of the LHM is being made to INS; CIA; G-2, Ft. McPherson, Georgia; Coordinator of Cuban Affairs, U. S. Department of State; U. S. Coast Guard; U. S. Customs, Miami; U. S. Customs, Region 2; U. S. Border Patrol; ONI; and, OSI.

In view of Bureau instructions that interview of REYNOLDS A. MOODY was not desired, and in view of the lack of any additional information that MOODY is engaged in Cuban revolutionary affairs, this case is being placed in a closed status.
