Following the interview with MOLINA by SA JAMES S. WEIR of the Houston Office, at Dallas, Texas, on 11/23/63, Chief of Police JESSE E. CURRY, Dallas Police Department, advised SA WEIR that MOLINA had caused the Police Department considerable trouble in the past by demanding such things as listing Mexicans as white persons rather than as Mexicans, and generally protesting alleged discrimination against members of the Mexican race.
