In view of the possibility that the marss of DL 1-5 and -S might be disclosed during the trial, you should contact e informats and point out this possibility to them. They entaid be advised that if such occurs they should make every feasible effort to maintain their relationship with the FBI in confidence. Point out to them that in similar situations informants, who mede themselves unavailable to the mens modia after being described as communists, were able to avoid embarracement and maintain thoir informant status.

Afford DL 1-3 and DL 6-8 close guidance and supervision. Keep the Bureau promptly advised of all pertinent developments in captioned matter.

Molina, a former Texas School Book Depository employee, was questioned on 11/23/63 concerning assassination of President Kennedy. Following this, a Dallas television station commented on the police interrogation of Molina and added that according to the Dallas Police, Molina had a subversive record in that department. Molina is now suing the Dallas television station. He is not known to us to have had any subversive associations; however, the Dallas Chapter of the American G.I. Forum, a veterans group comprised principally of Mexican-Americans, was subject of CP infiltration. Molina had been anticommunist and at no time participated in efforts of the CP. Reairtel points out that the defense for the television station through Lowery's testimony seeks to establish Molina's membership and activities in the Dallas Chapter of the American G.I. Forum during the time it was infiltrated by the CP. Furthermore, the defense anticipates developing evidence that would tend to show Molina had knowledge of the CP infiltration. and DL 6-S were cognizant of the CP efforts to infiltrate the Dallas G.I. Forum and were known by Lowery to be CP members. Reairtel states the trial may take place in approximately a month.
