

On November 11, 1963, Aldo Vera Serafin, 1382 North-west 34th Street, Miami, advised that about three weeks ago Sierra left Miami for Chicago; he has not seen him since that time and it is unknown if Sierra has returned to Miami.

Vera said Sierra wanted to participate in some military action against Cuba, the "Soresma" was going to be used as a mother ship for attack boats, but Sierra ran out of money and Aguilar's boat was confiscated. Vera stated his organization has no plans to engage in any raids, sabotage or infiltration missions against Cuba at the present time.
