On 1/28/60 SA W. HARLAN BROWN, received a typewritten report from DL-7-S, dated 1/20/60, which has been serialized as 134-4A-307:

Informant determined that on Sunday, 1/3/60 JIM COLEMAN, G. I. Forum member, was in contact with JOE LANDIN. COLEMAN said he had arranged for the Forum to bring Senator GONZALEZ as a speaker to Dallas. The Forum, however, at the last meeting had rejected COLEMAN's plan for the Senator's trip, JOE LANDIN told him. The Forum decided that they did not have the funds to provide for the Senator's trip.

During the conversation between these two, COLEMAN admitted he was angry at the Forum because of their reluctance to do anything constructive. He said he was only interested in seeing that Latin-Americans purchase more poll taxes. COLEMAN said at the Forum meeting LOWERY, JONES and MOLINA had been against sponsoring GONZALEZ' trip to Dallas.

COLEMAN stated he was going to call Senator GONZALEZ and tactfully tell him why his trip had been cancelled

Informant could furnish no additional information. All necessary action has been taken concerning the above.
