On 4/1/60 DL-7-S, who has furnished reliable information in the past, made available to SA W. HARLAN BROWN a typewritten report dated 3/28/60 concerning a CP meeting held at 1123 Ballard St., Dallas, Texas on 3/28/60. The original report is filed as 134-4A-319.

Those present were RUTH and BILL LOWERY, MARGARET and JOE LANDIN and AUGUSTIN ESTRADA.

ESTRADA apologized to the group for being so inactive and for having missed so many meetings in the past. He stated that his activity had been limited because of his father, but he felt that this alone had not made him inactive. He stated that he was facing this situation and had decided that he wanted to quit the party. He said that he had given this idea some thought and would bring it up at the next State committee meeting. During this meeting ESTRADA praised JOE and BILL for their contributions to the party. RUTH asked him if he wanted to give up his official post or just be a member or would he want to quit altogether. ESTRADA replied that he wanted to quit altogether. He said that he couldn't remember any contributions that he had made and that his quitting was for the best. MARGARET said that if he was worried because he had not made any contribution he should not quit because she and RUTH had not made any contributions either.

BILL reported that he did not attend the last meeting of the Community Committee for Better Schools. JOE said that he had received a brochure about candidate H. RHETT JAMES and a
