

On July 12, 1960, DL-6-5, in person, furnished a written report dated 7/11/60, to BA W. HARLAN BROWN. This report has been serialized as 134-1A-527.

Informant advised he had determined that a regular CP meeting was held at the home of BILL LOWERY on 7/11/60. Those present were BILL and BUTH LOWERY, AUGUSTIN ESTRADA, and JOE LANDIN. Informant also determined that HARGARET LANDIN stayed with MRS. ESTRADA when JOE LANDIN left to pick up AUGUSTIN ESTRADA and take him to the meeting.

At this meeting BILL LOWERY had 225 capies of the letter DR. GANCIA had given him. JOE LANDIN had reproduced the letter for BILL LOWERY. The letter was said to he about a Latin-American who was killed by a policeman in Riviera, Texas.

Informant's report reflected that BILL LOWERY. Chairman of the G.I. Forum, has called a special meeting of the Forum for Tuesday, 7/12/60. The Forum will help in organizing a local committee to aid the TREVINO survivors. The committee will be assed VICENTE TREVINO MEMORIAL COMMITTEE. BILL LOWERY inquired if the group present could arrange to distribute the leaflets in different places. He mentioned specifically the Neuhoff Meat Packing Plant. AUGUSTIN ESTRADA suggested that that work should be left up to the committee. JOB LANDIN said that if they did this work on their own they were sure to bring the wrath of the committee on them. BILL LOWERY also discussed the letter of introduction, that is the letter that was to accompany GARCIA's lotter. These letters, written by BILL LOWERY, AUGUSTIN ESTRADA, and JOE LANDIN, will be submitted to the Forum's committee. They will decide which one to use to mail out to the eleven Latin-American organizations. BILL LOWERY will give them
