On 7/27/60, DL-6-8, in person, furnished SA W. MANLAN BROWN a written report which was deted 7/25/60. roport has been serialized as 134-1A-528.

Informant's report reflected that a regular CP meeting was held at the bone of AUGUSTIN ESTRADA on Monday. 7/25/60. Those present were AUGUSTIN ESTRADA, BILL LOWERY, JOE LANDIN and MARGARET LANDIN. BUTH LOWERY did not attend this meeting.

BILL LOWERY reported on a recent talk he had had with GILBERT CARCIA, Chairman of the G.I. Forum. GILBERT CARCIA asked BILL LOVERY to keep Forum member JOE LANDIK from serving on special Forum committees. GARCIA explained to LOWERY that JOE LANDIN scared people by writing on controversial subjects; the Forum could not afford to lose any members. GARCIA also told BILL LOVERY that a Dallas Forum member had complained to him that JOE LANDIN had praised CASTRO in one of his articles. GARCIA wanted to know if JGS LANDIH held a responsible post in the Forum and if he were active. BILL LOWINY enswered that JOE was vice-chairman, but "was thinking of resigning," that JOB had not been active in quite some time.

During LOWERY'S conversation with GILBERT CARCIA Communism was montioned, and GANCIA told BILL LOWERY that he had recently investigated both BILL LOWERY and JOE LANDIN and found them to be in the "clear," the FDI had cleared them. GILBERT GARCIA also inquired about SAL RETRA, who in 1954, bad accused AUGUSTIN ESTRADA, BILL and JOE LANDING of being Party members. REYNA, BILL LOWERY told him, was through. REYNA was the first chairman of the Control Democratic Club in 1953-54.
