On 9/8/60, SA W. HARLAN BROWN received from DL-7-S in person a typewritten report dated 9/8/60. This report has been serialized as 134-4A-338.

This report stated that the Dallas regular CP meeting took place at the home of AUGUSTIN ESTRADA, 8/29/60. Those present were AUGUSTIN ESTRADA, BILL LOWERY and JOE LANDIN. MARGARET LANDIN, JOE's wife visited with MRS. ESTRADA.

At this meeting AUGUSTIN ESTRADA told BILL LOWERY that no one had made the State Committee meeting from Dallas; that he was ill and decided not to make the trip. ESTRADA also indicated that in spite of past failures, the Fort Worth CP must be contacted and activized.

BILL LOWERY had two letters with home, one from ED IDAR, the other from HECTOR GARCIA, both being officers in the American GI Forum. LOWERY had sent them a copy of his letter of resignation as Chairman of the Dallas Forum Chapter. Both IDAR and GARCIA praised him for the stand he took in the Trevino case and urged him to continue being active in the Forum.
