On 10/19/60 SA W. HARLAN BROWN received a typewritten report dated 10/18/60 from DL-7-S. This report has been serialized as 134-4A-343.

Informant determined there was a regular CP meeting held on 10/17/60 at 2230 Roanoke. Present were JOE and MARGARET LANDIN, BILL and RUTH LOWERY. AUGUSTIN ESTRADA phoned and said he could not make the meeting.

Informant determined that BILL LOWERY asked for a report on the Friday night Ft. Worth meeting. ESTRADA and LANDIN were to attend that meeting. JOE LANDIN explained that he had advised AUGUSTIN ESTRADA on Friday morning that he could not make it; he had to attend a Viva Kennedy-Johnson meeting on Saturday night at MEDRANOS. ESTRADA had told him that he would go by himself, and he must have gone as his wife (Mrs. ESTRADA) had called him at 10:45 PM to inquire about AUGUSTIN's whereabouts.
