

On 4/5/63 SA W. HARLAN BROWN received, in person, a handwritten report, dated 4/2/63, from DL-6-S. This report has been serialized as 134-1A-744.

Informant determined on 4/2/63 that ALBERT OROZCO, a Fort Worth school teacher, and a local leader of the American G.I. Forum, invited JOE LANDIN to be the speaker at a PTA meeting. LANDIN accepted the invitation. The school he was invited to was St. Mary of Carmel in West Dallas. OROZCO told LANDIN that the forum would be re-activated - it had not met in quite sometime. The next meeting would take place at the Little Mexico Village or at his home.

Informant had no additional information.
