Mrs. JOHN J. McLAUGHLIN, wife of the building superintendent, 184 Clarkson Avenue, Brooklyn, New York, advised on October 6, 1952, that the subject resides at this address and that he attends school on a full time basis.

Miss BEVERLY DRYCKER, Office of the Registrar, Brooklyn College, Brooklyn, New York advised SA JOHN SCANNELL on October 8, 1952, that GREENDLINGER is currently enrolled as a student at this institution.

Mrs. L. HIGGINS, Clerk, Local Board 44, 85 Flatbush Avenue, Brooklyn, New York, was unable to furnish additional information regarding the subject.

In addition to the Confidential Informants mentioned in reference report, confidential informant NY-769-S, who is familiar with some phases of Labor Youth League Activity in New York City and vicinity, advised SA STANLEY R. SHARP on October 10, 1952, that he could furnish no information regarding the subject.
