During their visit to Chile the members of the Cuban co-ordinating group held several meetings with Communists and Socialists, but refused an invitation to confer with representatives of the Chilean Christian Democratic Party (PDC). One Christian Democratic youth leader in Santiago suspected that the Cuban Government's harassment and forced exile of <u>Dr.</u>
Jose Sanacio 195,00 Guban Christian Democratic leader, was the real reason for the Cubans reluctance to meet with the Chilean Christian Democrats. The Cuban visitors did, however, have a session with the executive council of the rederacion de Estudiantes de Chile (FECh), at which they talked of "the common enemy" and discussed plans for the Latin American Youth Congre (LAYC) scheduled to be held in Habana in July 1960.

The PDC in Chile is now thoroughly split on the Guban question. The left wing of the party is for supporting the CASTRO revolution regardless of the consequences. The other group, led by Eduardo Frei Montalva, is for a policy of patience and continued observations 41

Somic, a leader of the left wing of the PDC, also prepared the second letter which the FECh sent to President Eisenhower. Regarding the proposed visit of the university student leaders to the United States at the invitation of President Eisenhower, Bernardino CANHUEZA a Christian Democrat, has been named to replace Roland SINO as the student representative from the University of Concepcion. All members of the group intend to visit Cuba on their return trip. The FECh is also planning to petition the Cuban Embassy in Santiago to allow three more-members, including a Christian Democrat, a rightist, and a representative of the Nente de Accion Popular (FRAP), to join the group when it reaches Cuba. Some Christian Democrats beleive that it would be a good idea for their representative, who would be Octavio MADA, to remain in Cuba for two Chile months to keep informed on arrangements for the LAYC and to make certain

that the guarantees promised to the Christian Democrats for attending, the congress are honored.
