JUNDING, FBI NO. 477053, J. P. DENARUE, FBI No. 427053, SIDNEY DOC-ECLWAY, FBI No. 76762 and EDNARD 3 1570NS, FBI No. 347381. LYONS believed to be identical with LFF and attached FBI No. believed to be identical with LEE and other individuals mentioned above believed to be associates of LEE and PERZIRA in widespread con racket. All offices requested to check indices and furnish EP any information re present whereabouts ILE and PEREIRA. PEREIRA described white, male, age 45, 6' la", 215 pounds, dark brown receding hair, brown eyes, olive complexion, black mustache, pleasant countenance, nice voice, fine clothes, probably driving '51, two tone blue, steel top convertible Cadillad. LEE described white, male, 6' 12' 185 pounds, light by an hair, blue eyes, 'hail fellow well met', maybe driving '50 black Cadillac."

For information of Minneapolis and Albuquerque Offices, Mrs. VIRGINIA VIN MORMAN, 3111 South Zunis, Tulsa, Oklahoma, appeared at Miazi Office March 26, 1951, requesting information concerning one JAMES LEE. As a result of the interview with Mrs. VAN NORMAN, it was ascertained that she met JAMES BRADLEY LEE, also known as J. Bradley tee and James Lee, at Hot Springs, Arkansas in June of 1950 at a horse show. LEE subsequently called her on the telephone on several occasions from Dallas, Texas; Reno, Nevada; Monterey, New Mexico; and Los Angeles, California. In July of 1950, LEE was reportedly at Grand Lake, Colorado and flew to Tulsa, Uklahoma, where he stayed for one week with Mrs. VAN NOR AN and her parents, Mr. and Mrs. C. A. KATHEY. He reportedly flew from Tulsa to Los Angeles after this visit and stayed at the Casa Manana in La Jolla, California.

Mrs. VAN NORMAN, at the time of interview, advised she had divorced her husband and expected to marry LEE and had given him at various times approximately \$9,500, \$2,000 of which

was in the form of a check on the National Bank of Commerce, Tulsa, Oklahoma, which she sent to LEE in Dallas, Texas on November 23, 1950, to purchase leases on oil land from a man by the name of SCILCWAY, reportedly residing on Fort Worth Avenue, Dallas, Texas, and believed to be identical with SIDNEY "DCC" SOILCWAY, FEI Number 75762.

According to Mrs. VAN NORMAN, LEE, on several of his frequent visits to her parents' home in Texas, had been accompanied by one GUS-HIMG, who was allegedly residing at the San Marcus Inn in Phoenix or the Westwood Hotel in Phoenix. Both Mrs. VAN NORMAN and her mother, Mrs. C. A. MATHEY, identified PAUL AUGUSTUS KING, FRI Number 2594295, from the Miami Con Man File as the GUS KING who is an associate of JAMES LEE. VAN NORMAN advised that KING and LEE at times had stayed at the Cosmopolitan Hotel in Colorado Springs, Colorado. KING was last known to the Miami Office to have been arrested in Miami Beach, Florida on March 19, 1947. The Miami Crime Survey file for 1947 and 1948 reflects that KING and FRADEROWN, alias Ralph-Grown, FBI Number 4506462, were arrested by the Miami Beach Police Department on March 19, 1947 in connection with swindles at Miami Beach hotels.

Miami miscellaneous file for ITSP cases contains a complaint dated January 13, 1950, concerning one JAMES LME, who swindled a Mrs. EDDAMOR ROWE NICHOLS of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, out of \$1,200 on New Years Eve of 1950 after dating her for three days and inducing her to pawn jewels to assist him in paying a gambling debt. No action was taken on this complaint by the Miami Office at that time in view of the lack of jurisdiction. The victim of the January 13, 1950 complaint at that time looked through the Miami Con Man File and positively identified LEE as EDWARD S. LYCNS, FBI Number 847381.

Both Mrs. VAN NCRYAN and her mother failed to identify LY-MS' photograph, however, as the JAMES LEE with whom they were acquainted, although both noted that the description furnished by Mrs. ELEANOR NICHOLS of Fort Lawlerdale, Florida fit LEE to perfection.

At the time of the interview with Mrs. VAN NORMAN, she advised that in addition to being associated with GUS KING, JAMES LEE was also acquainted with a TED SAUNDERS and a "JCCK" DOWDING whom Mrs. VAN NORMAN and her mother met on one occasion

when in the company of LEE. They were exhibited photographs of JOE P. DOWDING, with aliases "Jock", J. P. Bonahue, etc., FBI Number 477053, which Mrs. C. A. MATHEY advised she was reasonably certain was identical with the "JOCK" DOWDING with whom LEE was accuainted.

According to Mrs. VAN NORMAN, LEE, at the time of the interview in March of 1951, was negotiating with the man named SCLLOWAY of Fort Worth Avenue, Dallas, Texas, relative to oil leases and LEE reportedly maintained a mailing address in Dallas at 303 Southland Life Building.

Although the Miami file contains no current information relative to the individuals mentioned herein or in referenced El Paso teletype, Mizzi files indicate that these individuals are known to Confidential Informant SP-3, presently believed to be in contact with the Minneapolis Division. It is suggested that the Minneapolis Division contact Confidential Informant SP-3 for information as to further identity of JAMES BRADLEY LEE and the other individuals mentioned in instant letter.

The Oklahoma City Office is requested to contact Mrs. VIRGINIA VAN NGRMAN, 3111 South Zunis, Tulsa, Oklahoma, telephone 7-1967, Tulsa, for any further information she may have relative to LEE or his associates and on the possibility of obtaining additional photographs from Mrs. VAN NGRMAN.

Photographs of EDWARD S. LYCNS, FBI Number 847381, SAMUELLECLIOWAY, FBI Number 70702, and PAUL A. KING, FBI Number 2594295, are being forwarded as enclosures with instant letter to the El Paso Office for assistance in conducting investigation at El Paso.

Inaszuch as there appears no outstanding investigation in this division, this case is being considered RUC to the El Paso Office.
