On February h, 1954 so ject PEREIRA left Los Angeles on American Airline Flight 900 at 12:24 a. .. enroute to Fort North, Texas via Dallas, Texas.

On February 12, 1954 LLOYD AtHALEY, Manager, Security First National Bank, Beverly Hills, California advised that his bank had received a clipping from the Washington Post, Washington, D. C. dated on or about February 9, 1954 which indicated that the United States Supreme Court had upheld the conviction of PERBIRA and BRADING.

T-1 advised that PEREIRA returned to Ios Angeles on February 16, 195h and that BRADING was presently living with PEREIRA at the latter's home located at 151h Belair Road, Ios Angeles.
