On 4/22/68, NY 5938-S was contacted and advised he had just contacted GUILLERMO NOVO SANPOL, 1414 91st Street, North Bergen, NJ, a member of Movimiento Nacionalista Cubana, an anti-CASTRO organization, which has been engaged in terrorist activities in the past.

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NY 174-612
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NY 5938-S stated that he told GUILLERMO NOVO that he had passed the Spanish Tourist Office on Fifth Avenue on his way to work and noted that the front window had been broken. The informant asked NOVO if there was going to be a release and NOVO said "We will contact the press and claim credit for the bombings for Cuban Power." NOVO said that if they did not claim this for Cuban Power then the Cuban Nationalist Movement would be blamed for the incidents.

NY 5938-S advised that he was not certain whether or not GUILLERMO NOVO was responsible for the bombings or was just trying to take credit for these incidents in order to enhance his own reputation. The informant stated that he would maintain contact with NOVO and his brother, IGNACIO NOVO, for any additional information and would immediately notify the New York Office of any facts he develops.
