MM 724-S advised on March 13, 1962 that CARLOS RODRIGUEZ QUESADA and LAUREANO BATISTA FALLA, referred to in enclosed letterhead memorandum, stated they had made a release to the United Press and were informed that this demonstration would be given worldwide coverage. The press release, as explained by MM 724-S, will indicate that "President KENNEDY had been misinformed in connection with the ill-fated invasion of Cuba, April 17, 1961, and it is desired to prevent his being misinformed again, since he reportedly supports JOSE MIRO CARDONA, President of the Cuban Revolutionary Council." MM 724-S continued the demonstrators realized they were breaking the law, and although they did not want to break the law, they believed the cause needed national recognition; therefore, they held the demonstration.

Close liaison in this matter is being maintained with Detective Sergeant CHARLES SAPP, Miami Police Department, and upon receipt of initial information, he was so advised. (u)

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
