The original source of this investigation is MM 639-S, who, at the request of the Bureau, kept the Bureau informed of all activities undertaken by captioned subjects, which resulted in their arrest by the Miami Police Department for Armed Robbery and Grand Larceny. (X U)

During this investigation, close liaison has been maintained with local U. S. Government agencies, including ELMO RAINBOLT of the U. S. Border Patrol, as well as Detective Sergeant CHARLES SAPP, in charge of the Intelligence Unit of the Miami Police Department.

No further active investigation will be undertaken by the Miami Office in this matter; however, close liaison with the Miami Police Department will be continued and Bureau kept advised.

In view of the fact that the Department of Justice has advised they will not authorize prosecution against ROLANDO MASFERRER without written request from the U. S. Department of State, and this investigation is similar to the MASFERRER case, no further investigation is contemplated in instant matter.

FRANK FIORINI, mentioned in this report, is identical with FRANK ANTHONY STURGIS, aka, subject of Bufile 2-1499.

ALEX RORKE, mentioned in this report, is identical with former Bureau employee ALEXANDER I. RORKE, JR., formerly assigned as a clerk in the New York Office.
