Also immediately furnish full details and your comments covering following points: whether SA Davis, who was in telephonic contact with MM 635-S on two occasions on afternoon of 1/27/60, was aware of kidnaping plot directed against Masferrer at time of his two conversations with informant and could have reasonably been expected to consider possibility informant was involved in this plot, (2) whether SA Holloman was aware of informant's identity, either by name or by sight, prior to Holloman's meeting with subjects and was, therefore, cognizant of fact informant was to be included in impending arrests, and (3) whether, through microphone surveillance or other inquiries at hotel prior to meeting or during course of meeting, other Miami Agents participating in this matter (such as SA Davis or SA Albaugh) were aware that MM 635-S was involved prior to the time of the actual arrests.
