ARAGON advised that he had been notified during
the morning of 5/24/62, to meet MIRO CARDONA in Washington,
D. C. for the purpose of meeting with Representative HAROLD
COOLEY (Dem.-N.C.), Chairman of the House Agriculture Committee
who at that time was beginning hearings on the Sugar Act.

ARAGON advised that he arrived in Washington, D. C.
at 9:00 p.m. and met MIRO CARDONA at 9:30 p.m. at the
Washington airport. MIRO CARDONA and ARAGON then proceeded
to the Manger-Annapolis Hotel where they were registered.
