Re San Juan teletype to Bureau and Miami, 5/11/65.

MM 639-S, who has furnished reliable information in the past, on 5/12/65, advised that Comandos L (C-L), about 1½ years ago, split into two groups. ANTONIO QUESTA DEL VALLE and RAMON FONT SAUMELL took over the action group of C-L and moved operations to San Juan, P. R. *(X)*

U. S. Customs, Miami, on 5/12/65, advised that C-L action group of QUESTA and FONT has headquarters in San Juan and may be contacted through HENRY FERNANDEZ SILVA, 652 Roosevelt St., San Juan, telephone numbers 724-7070 and 724-5923. *A*

U. S. Customs said that C-L, for about the past 10 months, had been negotiating with the Government of the Dominican Republic for permission to set up a base of operations against Cuba, but, as yet, had not been given any such base.

U. S. Customs and established sources in Miami have no information concerning the plans of the seven C-L members at Jojuda, P. R. *105-117222-200*
