Indices SJO negative re PEDRO GUILLOT. Puerto Rico

*Cuba*

Indices SJO indicate that one LEONARDO A. CEBALLO PIERNAS, 499 Carpenter Road, Urbanizacion Valencia, Rio Piedras, Puerto Rico, INS #A-12 570 027 entered the United States at Miami, Florida on 8/19/60 seeking asylum. He was a professor of math at the University of Havana when the Government took over the University and the whole faculty had to resign.

A State Department communication dated 1/26/59 from U. S. Ambassador, Havana, indicates that one Dr. SEGUNDO CEBALLO PARERA was among a group applying for an in transit visa on their way to Rome to attend FOA conference.

*Cuba* *Italy*

It is not known if either of these individuals is identical to CEBALLO.

San Juan is in the process of attempting to further identify individuals mentioned in the letterhead in an effort to fully check indices of SJO.
