On October 21, 1966, a confidential source who has furnished reliable information in the past, furnished the following information:

On October 17, 1966, a meeting of the Board of Directors of the Cuban exile organization Brigada 2506 was held in Miami, Florida, from 8:00 P.M. to 1:00 A.M., wherein organizational problems of the Brigade were discussed. Present were 11 members of the organization from Miami, Florida, and one representative from the Puerto Rican chapter, MANUEL MOLINA GODINEZ. Although this was an organizational-type meeting since the Brigade is just beginning to once again emerge as an influential factor in anti-Fidel Castro activities, it was announced that according to a formal agreement signed by various anti-Fidel Castro organizations, the following three individuals would decide all military action: ~~SECRET~~

These three individuals are RAMON FONT SAUMELL of Comandos L, JORGE MAS CANOSA of Representacion Cubana En Exilio (RECE), and ANTONIO IGLESIAS of Brigada 2506. It was announced that no military action can be undertaken by any group without the unanimous consent of these three ruling military officers: ~~SECRET~~

Although it is known that the 30th of November exile organization has also signed a pact with the above three groups, no mention was made of their participation on the military ruling board. ~~SECRET~~
