Re SJairtel 10/27/66 captioned "Comandos L, IS-Cuba, Neutrality Matters," and "SJ 627-S, IS-Cuba."

A representative of the Department of the Army on 10/31/66 and a representative of CIA on 11/2/66 advised that their agencies have no operational interest in the activity described in re airtel. Miami expedite its check with these agencies locally.

San Juan immediately advise SJ 627-S that Bureau does not desire that he participate in the infiltration mission and that if he does he will be treated like anyone who violates U. S. laws.

Keep Bureau currently advised of all pertinent developments.
