that GRADY R. TURPIN had, during the evening of 6/22/65, advised him that he had been interviewed by an agent of the FBI on the same date at his home. TURPIN was visibly shaken by the experience and advised that he did not want anything further to do with the captioned group and was contacting informant as a warning that he too had better pull out. Informant advised that if further interviews are conducted with members of the captioned organization, he believes that their deterrent effect will completely destroy the organization as it presently exists.

ATTU, INTC, OSI, and Secret Service are each being furnished two copies of LHM locally.

Enclosed LHM is classified confidential inasmuch as unauthorized disclosure of the information could reasonably result in the identification of a confidential source of continuing value and compromise his future effectiveness.
