The following information is supplemental to the information furnished in letterhead memorandum of September 7, 1965.

The following information was furnished on September 21, 1965, by Dallas T-1:

Dallas T-1 advised that approximately 15 people had attended two meetings of the American Underground during the middle part of August, 1965, at the home of Delbert Ray in Midlothian, Texas. Dallas T-1 stated that he had heard that these meetings lasted approximately one to two hours and involved discussions concerning how the U.S. Government was infiltrated by members of the Communist Party or by individuals who are sympathetic to the goals of the Communist Party.

Dallas T-1 advised that at one of these meetings approximately one hour was spent in target or practice shooting with pistols by several members of the organization. Dallas T-1 stated that he was quite certain that Otto "Duke" Koling, and Arthur Pollard attended both of the above meetings. Dallas T-1 stated that he did not believe that the group was attempting to recruit any additional individuals to attend meetings of the organization and he did not know of any plans formulated by the group.

Dallas T-1 advised on October 25, 1965, that activities have been very quiet within the organization and as far as he knew, no meetings have occurred since the middle of August.
