Legat, Havana let to Bureau dated July 26, 1954, entitled, "SALVADOR DIAZ VERSON, FPM - CUBA," contents of which are set forth in referenced Miami letter to Bureau, September 24, 1954, entitled, "CARLOS PRIO SOCARRAS; et al, FPM - CUBA," contained information reflecting that the Legat had advised that DIAZ VERSON had been most cooperative with the Legat, but that indications were that much of his Communist information was not based on facts, but dreamed up, and also there was a rumor not confirmed that DIAZ VERSON had used his official position in the police to shake down individuals by threatening to accuse them of being Communists.
