SUBJECT: WILLIAM ALEXANDER MORGAN  
IS - CUBA

On January 5, 1959, PCI DONALD GEORGE ABBAJAY advised that he has known WILLIAM A. MORGAN about four years. He related that he worked with MORGAN at Mus-ad Inc. in 1956. According to PCI the Mus-ad firm was a company which produced music for commercial establishments. PCI ABBAJAY advised that IRVING "SLICK" SHAPIRO, aka, Toledo PD #C47585-18 and JOSEPH JOHN YOPPOLO, aka, Toledo PD #43476 who are well acquainted among the hoodlum element in Toledo were active in the management of Mus-ad. He added that MORGAN is also acquainted with other hoodlums in Toledo, Ohio.

*OHIO*

PCI ABBAJAY related that MORGAN had attended an electrical school where he acquired considerable knowledge of electrical engineering and was employed in that capacity with the Mus-ad firm.

PCI advised that while both were employed by Mus-ad he travelled to various cities with MORGAN and consequently became quite friendly with him. He described MORGAN as an aggressive and adventurous person who is a "little on the goofy side" but who has a strong sense of loyalty to his friends.

PCI ABBAJAY advised that prior to working for Mus-ad that MORGAN had claimed to have worked for Meyer LANSKY whom the PCI described as a fruit dealer and prominent figure in illegal activities in Florida.

PCI stated that he desired to bring to the Bureau's attention the information regarding MORGAN's criminal
