PCI DONALD GEORGE ABBAJAY on 2/23/60 had advised SA LAWRENCE A. WESTCOTT that he had just seen ROBERT A. BROWN who said that MORGAN had not been in Toledo recently. Source reported that, on the other hand, JACK LA RUE, A Toledo associate of BROWN and JOE YOPPOLO, Toledo Police Department #43476, had stated that subject had recently visited Toledo. PCI stated he would make additional discreet inquiries in an effort to ascertain if MORGAN had been in Toledo recently. During contact on April 4, 1960, PCI had no further information indicating that subject had so visited Toledo.

During contacts on March 31, 1960, April 4 and 25, 1960 CV 365-C had no further information concerning the possible presence of MORGAN in Toledo recently.

Further contact will be made with sources in Toledo in an effort to ascertain if subject has visited that city in the past several months and to further identify BOBYBROWN, BOBYMC CORMICK, and TONY NICKOLS (NICHOLS).
