- 3. Memorandum of SAB. E. DEFFENBAUGH, JR., to SAC, San Antonio, dated 3/6/64, containing information from SA 648-S which is originally recorded in San Antonio file 134-363A-182 (A) (U) copies of which were furnished to El Paso, Dallas, and Houston.
- 4. Memorandum of SA B. E. DEFFENBAUGH, JR., to SAC, San Antonio, dated 4/7/64, containing information from SA 648-S originally located in 134-363A-194, copies of which were furnished to El Paso, Dallas, and Houston.

The above-mentioned memoranda set forth names of individuals appearing at various times on Communist Party mailing lists. The purpose of instant memorandum is to record an analysis of various CP mailing lists which JOHN STANFORD has compiled, or helped to compile, within the past few years, which analysis was made by SA 559-S on 4/16/64.

Sufficient copies of instant memorandum are being furnished the Dallas, El Paso, and Houston Division so that their files may contain this analysis. Also, sufficient copies are being channelized to the files in the San Antonio Division to which the four abovementioned memoranda were channelized for completion of those files.

On 4/16/64, SA 559-S furnished the writer an oral report which was subsequently transcribed and thereafter acknowledged by Informant on 4/21/64. This report is located in 134-29A-1013, and contains the following information:

With respect to various CP mailing lists which JOHN STANFORD has compiled, or helped to compile, within the past few years, it is to be noted that these lists have contained several hundred names of individuals. It is believed that the great majority of these individuals do not have knowledge that their names are on this list, have not given their consent to having their names on this list, and, in all probability, would not agree with the aims and purposes of the Communist Party. JOHN STANFORD was recently in possession of such a Communist Party mailing list and commented that that list includes certain law enforcement agencies.
