Re Los Angeles letters to the Bureau dated 9/14/60 and 9/28/60, concerning contemplated travel plans of captioned subject.

LA 3402-S was in contact with LAWSON on 10/5, 6/60, and learned that he will return from his speaking tour to Northern California, Oregon and Washington, on 10/20 or 21/60. His wife, SUE, will not accompany him because of ill health. LAWSON is still seriously contemplating a trip to Europe for an indefinite stay. Informant does not know if LAWSON has a definite schedule for such a trip as yet; however, he did indicate that upon his return to Los Angeles from the current speaking tour, he intends to put his house up for rent or sale.

LAWSON told informant he is working on a paper requested by the Writers Union of the USSR on the subject of "The American Novel."

It is believed that informant will be in a position to learn essential data regarding LAWSON's contemplated trip abroad in due course; and the Bureau will be advised.
