Subject is a Communist key figure in the Los Angeles Field Division.

Reference is made to the report of Special Agent JOHN R. VICARS dated March 24, 1945, where, on page 2, the 1945 Communist Political Association registration card of subject is described.

CONF. INFO.

There is transmitted herewith, as an enclosure, a photographic copy of the 1945 Communist Political Association registration card of subject. It bears No. 47275, and is made out in the name of JOHN HOWARD LAWSON. It was furnished Bureau agents on February 26, 1945, by CNDI L.A. 2900. It is noted that nowhere on the card is it reflected that this is a Communist Political Association 1945 registration card; however, [CNDI L.A. 2613 can testify that this is the type of card used in the 1945 registration campaign by the Communist Political Association.] Moreover, CNDI L.A. 2900 advised that this card was transmitted to informant by ELIZABETH GLENN, former organizer of the Northwest Section, who now appears to act in the same capacity under the new cultural and miscellaneous group set-up.

One copy of this photograph is also maintained as an exhibit in Los Angeles file 100-18874-1a.
